Routine Childhood Immunizations during COVID-19 Pandemic

The COVID-19 pandemic continues to affect communities. By now, you're likely aware that government and public health officials are recommending that people do their best to stay at home to avoid contracting COVID-19, and you're probably doing just that. But it can be confusing to then get a call from your pediatrician's office reminding you about an upcoming appointment.

Maintaining childhood immunizations during this period is recommended by the American Academy of Pediatrics (AAP), the centers of Disease Control and Prevention (CDC) and California Department of Public health (CDPH).

If you are not sure what to do, call your pediatrician's office to see how important this particular visit is, and whether there are any immunizations needed.
